A.) District Popular Vote Update

**Mr. Anthony LoPresti, PMA** informed that this meeting is being held to give any updates regarding the District Popular Vote. Also covered within this meeting will be a quick synopsis was what the Committee "can and cannot do" regarding this whole process.

Mr. Picone reiterated; Election will be held January 25<sup>th</sup>, 2022 from 11am-6pm in each of the twelve Communities. Of note, as of now the majority of the Communities have consolidated to have one polling location but we are still awaiting notification from Winthrop. After confirmation completion and mandatory signatures, Mr. Rossetti and Mr. Picone will get the mandatory warrant delivered to all twelve (12) Communities for posting.

Joe DeSantis clarified that School Committee Members may advocate online, noting that he was in contact with the Office of Campaign and Political Finance (OCPF) and they informed as long as you don't have a paid/public position you may advocate online (please do not post title as School Committee positions) but to only advocate on your own behalf as a Citizen as well as may direct family members of SC members.

Other rules and details followed:

i.e. If you are a 'paid position holder at Northeast' you are not able to fund raise.

If paid by City/Town, you are allowed to advocate-as long as you are not paid directly From Northeast.

Even if there are multiple poling locations per Community, they must still be held on the exact date of January 25<sup>th</sup>, 2022, from 11am -6pm.

Chairman Nickole informed that there are many citizens emailing wanting to know where they can support the project by volunteering at polls. Therefore, if any reach out to SBC members please get their names and numbers and we can forward them to our PAC Committee. Mr. Nickole also noted that it is very encouraging all of the positive feedback that we have been receiving.

Mr. DiBarri reiterated clarification regarding Administration and staff members—"if they are not at work and not using any district technology, they are able to share on behalf of the project". This also goes for any family members of employees and/or administrators. Of important note, we can definitely share with and pass on information to (without crossing any lines) the PAC Committee.
