Popular Vote results – Mr. DeSantis noted that this is the first Building Meeting since the successful District-wide vote for the School Building Project' and he extended his sincere Congratulations. Informing that it was an amazing feat, that there were overall 9000 votes @ an almost 83% approval rate!

B.) Next Steps with Design/MSBA-

Overall project schedule-design phase 1-early work construct new school, demo old

Many highlights were informed on including the overall project schedule as follows:

- May/June '22-Submit DD Package to MSBA
- Jan/Feb '23-Submit 60% CD Package to MSBA
- May '23-Submit 90% CD Package to MSBA
- Aug '23 (targeted)-Submit 100% CD's to MSBA
- 2025-2026 School Year-NEW SCHOOL OPENS
- Late 2026-Abate/Demolish Existing School, Construct Athletic Fields/Final Parking

MSBA Reimbursement details were extended.

**Neil Benner, Gilbane-** took the floor and spoke regarding preconstruction phase-construction sequencing, many details were extended.

A synopsis of steps:

General building of site prep/foundation/etc. will move from East to West Leveling and building site preparation.

Cannot start anything until blasting is complete.

Essentially 3 separate buildings that will be combines and started separately.

**Foundations** 

Start site prep-early 2023 /summer-foundations/steel-end of 2023/rough ins, etc.

Looking to wrap up in **fall of 2025** —phase of new school.

Then demo of old building --phase 3.

(Timetables will be forth coming)

Many other specifics were informed on.

Floor was opened for questions and comments, some of the following items were noted:

Materials—obtaining time schedule (all available for public)—Neighbor notifications will be held/communication is imperative.

Timelapse with photographs and information [PMA provides].

Anticipate Students to start in 2025 (second half of school year).

Donations of old equipment—will be done.

E.) MEPA Advisory Opinion Request-Mass. Environmental Policy Act (jurisdiction) –20 day public comment period-Mr. DeSantis gave detailed explanation and noted that by the end of May we are expecting to hear the MEPA Advisory opinion. {This is an Environmentally sensitive project (impacts)}.

## G.) Public Comment Period-

Jennifer Kallay-Wakefield resident as well as on the Wakefield Municipal Electric & Natural Gas Board-Extended appreciation for the package that they received from Northeast regarding the Building Project and informed that they are very excited in the hopes of possibly working together.

<u>Barry Fogel-Advisory Commission MEPA Attorney</u> -Informed that he is representing MEPA for the Environmental impact of the Building Project. Many specifics were reported on. He also spoke regarding letter that was sent 'Advisory Opinion Request' (of which he has copies available today for anyone) and noted that he would love to speak further regarding the full environmental impact of this project.

<u>John - Wakefield Resident with elementary school students</u>-Notes that it is a shame how much forestry is being destroyed, blasting, and asked to please check out habitats as this is a very special area could potentially be destroyed.

<u>Jim Luciano</u>, <u>Wakefield Conservation Commissioner</u>-Asked regarding application for permit—also noted that information should be able to be reviewed for the 'resource areas'. Importantly no areas should be cleared near the resource areas. Informed that he is available for assistance.

Mr. Carl Franceschi of DRA Architects assured that this would happen at the end of design and development stage, and importantly noted that we are only in the investigation process as of now.

Robin Greenberg-Wakefield Environmental & Sustainability Committee-Noted that they are looking forward in the hopes of working with Northeast on this Building Project. [Cabon/Electrification/Construction]
