



- In summary- using base bid only, the bids came in \$388k under budget
- When considering the alternates scope, the bids came in \$816k over estimate (0.32%).
- In discussions with NEMT leadership, the project team is asking the District to recommend moving forward with the base bids + alternates pricing* (\$108,904,096) as the District is comfortable funding the \$816k/0.32% overage from available contingencies.
- *The \$108,904,096 does NOT include standard Gilbane markups that will bring the total Amendment value to \$114,277,437.75. Gilbane markup % were approved in the original contract signed in August 2021.

Contracting-Buyout Update- Overall

- Construction Budget: \$250,241,158
- When factoring in the early packages and MGL CH. 149A contractors, 70% of the estimate project cost has been contracted.
- Gilbane is currently reviewing bids/seeking bids for the remaining 30% of the construction scope (i.e. Drywall, Abatement/Demolition).
